1. INTRODUCTION

QNX License Supplements provide supplementary licensing information for the QNX Software Development Platform version 7.0 (“QNX SDP 7”) product and for compatible QNX products (any one or more including QNX SDP 7, the “QNX 7 Product Portfolio”). QNX License Supplements provide a high-level description of the licensing model for QNX 7 Product Portfolio products and set out third party licensing considerations that apply to the QNX 7 Product Portfolio product. All capitalized terms used but not defined in this License Supplement have the respective meanings ascribed to them in the QNX Development License Agreement (or “QDL”).

Sections 2 to 5 of this License Supplement cross-reference, and may supplement or revise, the current QNX License Supplement for the QNX SDP 7 product which provides an overview of the elements of the QNX Product Portfolio licensing model, information on the QDL that applies to the QNX Product Portfolio, and a framework for the interpretation of the licensing related information contained in the Notice Files and Open Source Software (“OSS”) Compliance Files. Section 6 of this License Supplement sets out information on licensing considerations with respect to the QNX Web Browser 2.0 Software (“Browser 2.0” or “Browser 2.0 Software”) product including any supplementary licensing terms and conditions that apply to this product including terms and conditions relating to Third Party Licensed Code. Before adopting the Browser 2.0 product, your developers should review the applicable licensing information and special considerations set out in the Notice Files, OSS Compliance Files, and License Supplement(s) that apply to this product.

2. QNX 7 PRODUCT PORTFOLIO LICENSING MODEL

2.1. NOTICE FILES

The Notice Files for the Browser 2.0 product contain the following information/attribute fields setting out the information for that product:

Field	Content Description
Support Provided	Indicates the level of support available for the referenced components. “ Full ” means support by QSS under its Standard, Priority and Custom Services Plans or other QSS enhanced support agreements. “ Custom ” means QSS will provide support, but only under the terms of its Custom Services Plan or other QSS enhanced support agreements. “ Unsupported ” means QSS does not provide support for the referenced component(s).
Type of Software	These terms are used in the QDLs and other QSS license agreements in risk allocation provisions relating to the associated technologies. “ Type I Software ” (also known as “Core Software”) indicates Commercially Released Software, other than Type II or Type III Software (see your QDL for definitions of “Commercially Released Software”). It typically includes QSS proprietary code and may include some third party proprietary and open source code elements. “ Type II Software ” (also known as “Collateral Software”) indicates Commercially Released Runtime Components identified as “Type II”. It may include third party proprietary and some open source code elements. “ Type III Software ” or “ As Is Code ” (also known as “As Is Software”) indicates Software that is licensed, or sublicensed by QSS strictly on an “as is”

	basis. It typically includes primarily Experimental, third party proprietary and/or open source code elements.
Runtime Redistributable	Indicates that a file for which this attribute field is set to “true” is eligible for distribution as part of a Target System.
End User Licenses	Indicates the end user license terms or where to find such terms.
QSS Offer of Source	Sets out corresponding QSS offer(s) of source for any OSS software component(s) included in the applicable software package.

3. QNX DEVELOPMENT LICENSE AGREEMENT

Any one or more of the QNX 7 Product Portfolio products are licensed by QNX Software Systems Limited (“QSS”) for development purposes under the QDL, a copy of which is provided in the QNX Software Center and which is also found at <http://licensing.qnx.com/info/>. Please see the applicable description and additional information in the corresponding section of the current QNX License Supplement for the QNX SDP 7 product.

6. LICENSING CONSIDERATIONS

6.1. QNX LICENSED PRODUCTS

As set out in the QNX Product Portfolio Guide and the QDL, QNX Licensed Products are specialized QNX products that extend the capabilities of the operating system and are separately licensed from the QNX SDP 7.x product and may have different licensing models. The applicable License Supplement, together with the other terms and conditions of the QDL, provide the terms and conditions upon which QSS authorizes you to use QNX Licensed Product Software for commercial development purposes. Your QNX Licensed Product

entitlement is defined by the Development License Certificate you are issued by QSS or one of its authorized distributors. All defined terms in the QDL will have the same meanings in this License Supplement. While such licensing considerations, together with other third-party licensing considerations known to QSS, are further described in the Licensing Considerations Matrices below, these matrices are not a comprehensive list and do not constitute legal advice. You must consult your own legal advisor to determine and satisfy your own licensing obligations.

6.2. QNX PLATFORM FOR BROWSER 2.0 LICENSING

6.2.1 BROWSER 2.0 LICENSING - GENERAL.

The additional license terms in this License Supplement, including any licensing considerations set out in the table in Section 6.3 below, are incorporated into the QDL and together provide the terms and conditions upon which QSS authorizes you to use the Browser 2.0 Software for development under the applicable License Class, provided that you first obtain a corresponding Development License Certificate. The provisions specific to Browser 2.0 set out in this License Supplement will prevail in the event of a conflict between any of the within provisions and the QDL.

Your License, and its specified License Class, only extends to the Browser 2.0 product set out in this License Supplement and in the corresponding Development License Certificate you have been issued and only includes Updates thereto that QSS may, in its sole discretion, make available to you for use under this License (included as part of the "Software" for the purpose of the QDL). Other QNX Licensed Products may be available under separate License Supplements and specifically identified Development License Certificates.

6.2.2. DEVELOPMENT LICENSE GRANT AND CONSIDERATION.

Browser 2.0 is an optional QNX Middleware component that extends the capabilities of the QNX SDP 7 Software and can be installed by any user with a valid commercial QNX SDP 7 license. Your Browser 2.0 Software license is conditional on you having and maintaining (i.e., paying the annual Maintenance and Support Services fees) a valid commercial QNX SDP 7.x license for all developers involved in your Development Projects. Subject to the terms and conditions of the QDL and this License Supplement, QSS hereby grants to you a limited, non-exclusive, personal, non-sublicensable, non-transferable (except as contemplated in Section 21 (Assignment) as modified by section 6.2.7 (Assignment) below) an indivisible license for the Browser 2.0 Software on the same terms and conditions specified in the QDL, except as modified by this License Supplement. Any license rights to Updates that QSS may make available to you as part of your Browser 2.0 Software license are conditional upon your acceptance of any additional license terms and conditions (by way of further written amendment or new agreement), third party licensing prerequisites and the associated updated License Supplement and updated Notice Files. Any Update provided that is not Commercially Released Software will be considered Experimental Software for the purposes of the QDL, including but not limited to, Section 15.2 (Experimental Software).
